On August 25, Pastor Miguel returned to Guadalajara with his physical and spiritual batteries recharged looking forward to getting back into the work. Please pray for their safety. The drug cartels are causing much unrest in that city of 9 million with random murders. You may remember that Pastor Miguel's wife, Clement, went to be with the Lord almost two years ago. Please continue to pray that God would bring just that special lady into his life to be his helpmeet. The Lord knows how difficult it has been for him. It is a big responsibility for any lady to take on that important roll of pastor's wife and mother. He has put this in the Lord's hands and only wants God's will for his life.

Please pray for the health of Pastor Enrique Mejia, a dear friend, who is ministering in the northeast section of the Dominican Republic, one of the poorest areas of that country. He has a real burden to reach his people with the Gospel and has been successfully using the book, *Becoming a True Christian*, in Spanish. The cost of importing my book into the country is prohibitive. They have a great desire to print the book in Santo Domingo and he has taken on this project.
