Dear Praying Friends,

This Christmas was most enjoyable with a Christmas-birthday party on the 23<sup>rd</sup> given in our home by our Sunday School Bible class. As we gathered in our front room it was an extra treat to hear the Handel's Messiah as we enjoyed the food and fellowship together! On Wednesday our son, Chuck, came from Georgia to spend the better part of 4 days with us. We had a wonderful time in fellowship, fishing and fun.

One of the enjoyable experiences that we had this year while on our trip to Indiana was that a lady, Susan Moore, introduced herself to me after the service in one of the churches where I preached. She later wrote a note to us as follows: "It was so good to see you both when you came to Burge Terrace on September 24th. John and I joined that church almost 11 years ago, and we didn't know that they supported your work while you were in Mexico. What a wonderful surprise to look over and see you sitting there by the Pastor. God brought you there to preach on my 77th birthday! (I was born the first time on September 24, 1940, and born again on January 20, 1956, just before you left the first time for the mission field.) And to top it off, Dotty came and sat right beside me— **right beside me**, and I couldn't stop smiling. Our church didn't know the connection, but the Lord certainly did! Just look at His timing! That evening the Lord Jesus Christ came into my life and turned everything around." We praise the Lord with her!

Recently I was asked the question, "How many people had come to salvation through our ministry of 63 years?" My answer was simple, "There is no way that I could ever keep the record, but only eternity will reveal the true facts. I love how the Apostle Paul responded to a similar situation in 1 Corinthians 3:6-7, "I have planted, Apollos watered; **but God gave the increase**. So then neither is he that planteth any thing, neither he that watereth; **but God that giveth the increase**." Dotty, and I have only been the vehicles that God has used, but you who have prayed for us and supported us so faithfully, which is the powerful engine behind what has been accomplished for Him. We are also grateful to the Lord for how He has given healing to her mind. For the major part the confusion caused by the medication has subsided, for which we are grateful.
