South Carolina and Georgia enabling us to minister to many

I held evangelistic services in a Spanish-speaking church in
Winter Garden, and again, in October in a Spanish-speaking
church in Pensacola, Florida. The following week I had the
opportunity to preach and represent Baptist World Mission at the

During our travels this past summer Dr. Ron Comfort asked me to return the first week of December to

We are also very occupied in a new revision of the English version of *Becoming a Christian* to be used by

edit my messages in Spanish for use on several radio stations that have requested them.

You will be blessed, as we were, to hear that our church in Guadalajara sent us an offering of \$1,600 for the
placement of the book, *Becoming a Christian*, in the State and Federal Prisons of California and Illinois.
Our present need is to fill the many requests for the book which we are receiving from individual inmates
from the State Prisons in Texas. As you will recall, we have offered each inmate the book, *Becoming a
Christian*, free of charge for those who request it. Until we receive more donations for the State Prisons of
Texas we will no longer be able to send them books. If you know of anyone or a church that would be led to
